MID-CONSTRUCTION UPDATE:

RICHARDSON 208 ALPINE DRIVE – NEW HOUSE

Currently the primer paint on the house is in preparation for the final top coat.

Kelly presented final color samples for new house under construction.

Behr “imperial grey” will be the color of all of the siding and window trim.

Gutters will be “storm grey”. Grey pavers will be substituted for the Trex decking that was originally approved. Due to cost restraints, the stone highlights will not be installed at this time.
