1. Boulder County Emergency Mass Notification System (Reverse-911)

This system is the means by which Pine Brook Hills residents can be notified of critical emergency situations, including the need to evacuate due to the threat of wildfire. You may elect to receive notifications via any or all of the following methods:

- ➔ Home phone
- ➔ Work phone
- ➔ Mobile phone
- ➔ Text message
- ➔ E-mail

is **not** a substitute or replacement for Reverse-911.

Please note that these systems are neither affiliated with each other or with the Pine Brook Hills Homeowners Association. ***You need to enroll separately in each.***

3. Reporting an Emergency:



Please remember that, here in the mountains, *seeing smoke constitutes an emergency!* Call 9-1-1 for any emergency. Our PBH Emergency Services will be immediately notified.

Do not call the fire station directly as it is not staffed at all times.
